AUTUMN 1 TERM IN YEAR 1

Maths

Autumn 1 - We will revisit numbers 0-10 and understand the numberness of the numbers through a wide range of practical activities. We will focus on number recognition, place value and part and wholes. We will also practise our number formation throughout this half term.

English

Autumn 1 - We will be reading and completing a range of activities linked to What the Ladybird Heard this half term. We will begin to look sentences and how we can write them using the correct punctuation and grammar. We will begin to learn about adjectives and become adjective detectives. We will continue to practise our phonics daily.

RSHE -Friday

Autumn 1 - Our topic is 'Being Me in My World.' We will build up our self awareness throughout this half term, we will being to appreciate and understand how each of us are unique and individual and we should celebrate our differences. This will be reinforced by revisiting our rights and learning about responsibilities.

Computing - Thursday

Autumn 1 - We will be investigating Internet Safety. This topic is open to Year 1 children and the problems they see with the internet at this moment in time.

Geography - Tuesday

Autumn 1 - Our topic is our "Local Area" we will look at our school grounds and the local area. The children will identify human and physical features in their local area of Teams. They will learn about Ordnance survey map symbols by looking at maps of Teams and use aerial photographs to create their own map of the local area.

DT-Friday

Autumn 1 - Our topic is 'Vehicles' During this topic children will explore a range of vehicles. They will investigate how vehicles move before designing and making their own.

Science - Monday

Autumn 1 - Our topic is 'Animals, including humans.' We will identify and name a variety of common animals that are birds, fish, amphibians, reptiles and mammals. We will identify and name a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores. We will also identify, name, draw and label the basic parts of the human body and say which part of the body is associated with each sense.

Religious Education - Wednesday

Autumn 1 - Our topic is 'Creation" Children will be able to retell the story of creation from Genesis 1:1-2.3 and recognise that 'Creation' is at the beginning of the 'big story' of the Bible

Physical Education - Wednesday morning, Thursday afternoon - Mrs Smith

Autumn 1 - Pupils will experience working with a variety of equipment and to explore individual skills during play. In all games activities, pupils will learn movement skills relevant to games. Pupils will begin to make use of space and start to think about outwitting an opponent. Will begin to watch and describe others' performances, as well as their own. To keep and run a game using a set of rules.

Music -Wednesday

Autumn 1 - Our music lessons shall focus on learning to listen and appraise. Children will learn about the differences between pulse, rhythm and pitch and to learn how to rap and enjoy it in its original form.

Phonics and Reading daily

Reading is an invaluable part of your child's education and is key to learning in all subjects across the curriculum. We aim to develop our children into confident and fluent readers, and to broaden their vocabulary, by exposing them to a rich diet of high-quality texts from a range of different genres.
