

## Maths

**Autumn 2** - We will build up our understanding of number to 20. We will spend time looking at number bonds to 10, this will help to further develop our understanding of the number system. We are consolidating addition and subtraction, putting into practice what we know. We will then move on to learning about 3D and 2D shape through a range of practical activities.

## English

**Autumn 2** - This half term we will be reading different Traditional Tales including The Three Little Pigs and Jack and the Beanstalk. Using these texts we will learn how to write simple instructions, a simple narrative and speech bubbles. We will continue to practise our phonics daily.

## PSHE -Friday

Autumn 2 - Our topic is Celebrating differences within each other. We will be looking at the meaning of similarity and difference and will be identifying similarities and differences in our class. We will learn that it is good to be different.

## Computing - Thursday

Autumn 2 - Our topic we are celebrating. In this topic we will learn how to use a simple process to create a celebration card electronically. We will look at lots of different card genres and think about appropriate colour schemes for our cards.

## History - Tuesday

Autumn 2 - Children will be comparing the life of the children now with the life of their grandparents as children. The children will compare toys and photographs of the local area in the 1970s and now. They will ask historical questions to find out about the similarities and differences between their life now and the life of their grandparents as children.

## Art -Friday

Autumn 2 - Our topic is 'weather,' This unit is based around the different types of weather which children experience on a day to day basis. Children will use artists' representations of weather as a basis to create their own work.

## Science - Monday

Autumn 2 - Our topic is 'Materials' Children will learn the name and purpose of a range of everyday materials, becoming familiar with their properties. They will carry out an experiment to find out the best use of the everyday materials they have learned about at the end of the topic.

## Religious Education -Wednesday

Autumn 2 - we will look at two different topics this half term, Children will know the legend Sita and Rama and be able to retell the story. They will explore the Hindu festival of light -Diwali- and reflect on the celebrations. Children will know the story of the birth of Jesus and will know what happens at Advent. Children will know what gifts are worth more than money and will understand that Christmas is a time for being thankful

## Physical Education - Wednesday and Thursday

Autumn 2 - Children will explore simple body movements and actions using different parts of their bodies. Pupils will express feelings, moods and ideas in response to different types of music and using a range of stimuli. Students will work with a partner or in small group and evaluate and assess movements to improve overall routines.

## Music - Wednesday

Autumn 2 - All the learning is focused around two songs: Rhythm In The Way We Walk (Reggae style) and Banana Rap (Hip Hop style). Children will Listen & Appraise other styles of music and continue to embed the interrelated dimensions of music through games and singing.

## Reading-daily

## Library- Wednesday

Reading is an invaluable part of your child's education and is key to learning in all subjects across the curriculum. We aim to develop our children into confident and fluent readers, and to broaden their vocabulary, by exposing them to a rich diet of high-quality texts from a range of different genres.

Children will visit the library and have the opportunity to borrow a book to enjoy at home and to be returned to school the following week.
