

Maths

Spring 1 In maths we will count to 20, forwards and backwards, beginning with 0 or 1, or any given number. We will count, read and write numbers to 20 in both numerals and words. We will add and subtract one-digit and two digit numbers to 20, including zero. We will work on solving one step problems that involve addition and subtraction, using concrete and pictorial representations.

English

Spring 1 In English this half term we will first focus on the text 'Beegu,' which we will base our character profile on. We will work hard to re-read our work and make appropriate changes to improve it. Our Second text will be 'The Jolly Postman'. We will use this text to help us will learn about letter writing and produce and send a letter of our own.

PSHE - Friday

Spring 1 - This half term we will be looking at dreams and goals. We will look at what it means to be successful and will set ourselves some simple goals that we can succeed in. We will look at how we can plan to achieve our goals and will learn to celebrate achievement.

Computing - Monday

Spring 1 - This term the children will learn about using programmable toys. We will be using BeeBots in this topic and will be learning about inputting sequences of instructions to program the toy. We will learn about what an algorithm is and will look at debugging a BeeBot.

History/Geography - Tuesday

Spring 1 - Children will gain a knowledge and understanding of life in Victorian times and compare this to the reign of our late Queen Elizabeth II. We will explore what life was like for children and their families and think about what era we'd prefer to be part of.

Art and Design Technology -Friday

Spring 1 - Healthy Eating During this topic children will gain a deeper understanding of the importance of healthy eating. They will learn how to safely prepare a range of foods and make and follow their own healthy recipes. They will gain the knowledge that some foods should be eaten as a treat and in moderation.

Science - Thursday

Spring 1 - During this half term, the children will be exploring forces. We will explore and investigate forces in actions such as push and pull and discover a little more about these in our environment

Religious Education - Wednesday

Spring 1 - The aim of this unit is to enable the children to develop their understanding of the good news Jesus brings. We will learn about how Jesus gives instructions to people about how to behave and how Christians follow the teachings of forgiveness, peace and friendship.

Physical Education - Monday and Thursday

Spring 1 - This half term we will be focusing on gymnastics. We will be learning to do different jumps and will be focusing on the correct technique when landing. We will also be continuing to build on our gross motor skills throughout this term.

Music - Wednesday

Spring 1 - This term we will be learning In The Groove, a song that will help the children to learn about different styles of music. This is a very easy song to learn and has been arranged in six different styles; Blues, Baroque, Latin, Bhangra, Folk and Funk. Each week we will listen and learn a different style of In The Groove.
