

Maths

Summer1- This half term we will be focusing on place value and counting in 2's, 5's and 10's. We will be developing a deeper understanding of number to and above 20. We will develop skills to help us understand new concepts such as partitioning for addition and subtraction. Our homework each week will reflect this and support our learning in class.

English

Summer 1 - This half term we will be reading *The Tiger who came to Tea* by Judith Kerr and *Lost and found* by David Jefferson. These books will support our activities which will support our writing of, character profiles, informal letters and a narrative. We will also continue to take part in daily phonics activities.

PSHE - Friday

Summer 1- we are going to be looking at Relationships this half term, we will take a look at healthy friendships, what it takes to be a good friend and thinking about how we can be our own best friend. We will be looking at families and how everybody's family is different even if they look the same. We will be using story books to support this unit.

Computing - Monday

Summer 1- We are Collectors in this unit we will learn how to find images of a given subject, learn how to save, then use in a specific programme and then sort into groups. We will learn the importance of selecting just what we need and use our other skills which we have learned so far this year to create a yes no quiz by creating an algorithm. We will make links to our science topic.

History - Tuesday

Summer 1- This half term we will be learning about Florence Nightingale and the work she carried out as a nurse and earned the name "Lady of the Lamp". We will learn how she changed nursing and compare hospitals of then and now.

Art -Friday

Summer 1- This unit is based on the art of weaving. The children will explore a range of textiles pieces from Sue Spooner who creates weave tapestry pieces using hand-dyed yarns coloured with her own dye recipes. They will identify the patterns and colours used and use these as a basis for creating their own art.

Science - Thursday

Summer 1- This half term our topic is plants and we will be learning how to Identify and name a variety of common plants, including garden plants, wild plants and trees, and those classified as deciduous and evergreen. We will also learn how to Identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including roots, stem/trunk, leaves and flowers

Religious Education -Wednesday

Summer 1 -During this half term we are going to deepen the children's understanding of the concept of belonging through exploring the celebration of Baptism. We will look at the children's personal experience and invite them to bring in memories from their own baptisms.

Physical Education - Monday and Friday

Summer 1- Athletics In this unit pupils will experience simple modified running, jumping and throwing activities. We will accurately replicate running challenges and competitions that require speed and stamina. In all athletic based activities, children will engage in performing skills and measuring outcome as a marker of performance. We will develop the ability follow rules safely and handle equipment correctly.

Music - Wednesday

Summer 1 - Imagination, In this unit we will learn a root song, a song about using your imagination and sing it with lots of different styles of backing music. We will listen to songs from famous films including *Mary Poppins*. I wonder if you know any songs with the word imagination?

Reading- Daily

Reading is an invaluable part of your child's education and is key to learning in all subjects across the curriculum. We aim to develop our children into confident and fluent readers, and to broaden their vocabulary, by exposing them to a rich diet of high-quality texts from a range of different genres.
