Maths

Summer 2 - We will start the with geometry and build our vocabulary and understanding around this through practical activities. We will continue to build our confidence using number to 100 and practice saying our 2, 5 and 10times table in our everyday activities. We will also focus on money and begin to tell the time on the hour, half hour and quarter past the hour.

English

Summer 2 – This half term we will reading 2 fiction texts The Robot and the Bluebird by David Lucas and Two Monsters by David Mckee. We will use these texts to support our writing of instructions and a short narrative, bringing together everything we have learned this year

PSHE -Friday

Summer 2- Changing Me

This half term we will be taking a look at how we have changed so far in our lives, we will look at the developments we have made and challenges we have overcome. We will also focus on looking forward and transitions.

Computing - Monday

Summer 2- Sphero's

In this unit of work we will learn how to correctly use and control a Sphero. We will direct it across maps and to find different items using our programming skills with the use of an Ipad.

Geography - Tuesday

Summer 2- How does the weather effect my life -

This unit is based around the weather. The children will learn about the months of the year and seasons. They will consider weather in the UK and the effects that this has on themselves, people and the environment.

Design and Technology -Friday

Summer 2- This unit allows children to watch a puppet shows to gain ideas of how they would like their own designs to be. They will design and make their own characters, thinking carefully about the features of their characters

Science - Tuesday

Summer 2- Vera Rubin - Astronomer

This half term we will be exploring, investigating and researching the work of Vera Rubin as we study women in science. We will learn all about her story and how she became famous including the struggles she faced as a female scientist in order for her to triumph in her field.

Religious Education - Wednesday

Children will be able to explain what happens when a Muslim baby is born. They will be able to describe what happens at an Aqiqah ceremony comment on the importance of giving within the Aqiqah ceremony.

Physical Education - Monday and Wednesday

This half term we will continue to practice our athletic skills, running, jumping, throwing, skipping and hopping. We will learn how to correctly and safely land and stop to prevent injuries, we will also learn a range of different throwing techniques.
