Maths

Summer 2 We will: write algebraic expressions; use substitution to find missing values in algebraic expressions; solve algebraic equations; find pairs of numbers that satisfy an equation with two unknowns; draw and interpret line graphs, pie charts and bar charts; find the mean of data; classify, measure and draw angles; find missing angles in a right angle, straight line and triangle

English

Summer 2 - We will be reading and discussing the plays of William Shakespeare. We will be focusing on the use of archaic language and consider how these stories can be retold in modern English. We will write a playscript inspired by Shakespeare. We will also recount our pilgrimage to Holy Island, using a range of punctation and grammar features that we have covered in KS2.

PSHE - Wednesday

Summer 2 - We will be continuing our Young Leaders Archbishop of York project. This is a project aimed at supporting and helping people in the local community. We will investigate how we can improve the local area and plan a project to ensure we have a positive impact on the community.

Computing - Thursday

Summer 2 - We will be using Book Creator to create our Leavers 2022 Yearbook. We will consider audience, purpose, atmosphere and structure when planning a particular outcome, and use a range of multimedia, recognising the contribution of each to achieve a desired effect.

Geography - Wednesday

Summer 2 - How does our local area and region meet people's needs? The children will explore the regional, national and international links to the local area of Gateshead and will use fieldwork skills to investigate how our local area and region meets the needs of people. They will learn about how different coastal features are formed and consider the impact of tourism on Holy Island of Lindisfarne.

Design and Technology - Friday

Summer 2 - Textiles - This unit allows children to research fashion designers and have an understanding of how cotton is manufactured in order to make the textiles. Children will design their own pattern pieces to make a drawstring bag to carry their leavers goods in.

Science - Monday

Summer 2 - Women in Science - Mae Jemison - We will be researching the life and achievements of astronaut and doctor Mae Jemison. We will be carrying out scientific enquiries inspired by her work and investigating the answers to our own scientific questions.

Religious Education - Thursday

Summer 2 - Islam - Children will explore the 5 Pillars of faith and look at the basic duties which all Muslims should perform. They will investigate the 5 Pillars and understand that although they are essential to Islam they are not the whole of Islam.

Physical Education - Tuesday and Wednesday

Summer 2- In this unit of athletics, children will focus on core skills needed to compete in athletics events including: distance running, sprints, throwing events and jumping events. The will compete weekly in their school teams and to beat PB records set.

MFL - Friday

Summer 2 - In this final unit children will be able to describe an Olympian by their sporting title and say what particular sport they play using the verb fare.

Music - Tuesday

Summer 2 - Caribbean. The children will learn about the historical and cultural foundations of Caribbean music, especially reggae and calypso. They will perform 2 songs and also have an opportunity to write their own lyrics. Caribbean music uses a lot of percussion and the 'clave' rhythm so the children will explore composition and performance in this style.

Reading

Reading is an invaluable part of your child's education and is key to learning in all subjects across the curriculum. We aim to develop our children into confident and fluent readers, and to broaden their vocabulary, by exposing them to a rich diet of high-quality texts from a range of different genres.
