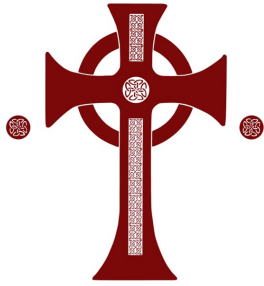
Miss Walker will be leaving us in July to begin a teacher training programme. We wish her lots of luck.
