The children learnt about the work of St Aidan and his



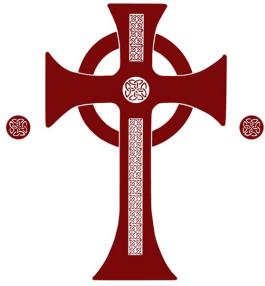
